## SYDNEY - KATOOMBA

### ● SYDNEY (Start)

For an unforgettable start to your journey, treat the family to a day out at Darling Harbour. Come face-to-face with some of the world's most fascinating underwater creatures at the Sea Life Sydney Aquarium before saying hello to the friendly koalas next door at the Wild Life Sydney Zoo. On the way out of town, be sure to stop off at the Royal National Park and make a splash at Wattamolla.

### ● WOOLLONGONG (88.5km)


Just under two hours from the CBD, Wollongong is a great spot for you and the family to stretch your legs and recharge. Wander through one of the largest Buddhist temples in the Southern Hemisphere, Nan Tien, in the nearby suburb of Berkeley. Then, if you get peckish, pick up some takeaway in town and head to the Botanic Gardens for a picnic by the pond.

### ● JERVIS BAY (116km)

After a relaxing stop in Wollongong, head south to Jervis Bay for some outdoor fun. From surfing to paddle boarding, there's plenty of fun things to do with the kids at the beach. On shore, pick up a bike hire and explore the parklands or, if you're feeling brave, hop on the flying fox at Trees Adventure.

### ● CANBERRA (222km)

Canberra may be the political centre of the country, but there's still heaps of family friendly things to see and do in the ACT. Located in the heart of town, Questacon is a science and technology centre that has a wide range of rides and activities for the kids. To take it up a notch, head over to the Canberra Reptile Zoo for a tour through their ever-expanding enclosure.




## **BOWRAL (178km)**
